



**ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2000
APPLICATION FOR ELECTRICITY GENERATION AND SALE LICENCE**

Wangaratta Solar Farm Pty Ltd (ACN 608 644 435)

RECORD OF DECISION

7 December 2022

SUMMARY

Pursuant to section 19(1) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (Industry Act), the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has granted Wangaratta Solar Farm Pty Ltd (ACN 608 644 435) (Wangaratta Solar Farm) a licence to generate electricity for supply or sale, and to sell electricity to the wholesale market at the Wangaratta Solar Farm located in the vicinity of North Wangaratta, Victoria.

BACKGROUND

Section 16(1) of the Industry Act provides that a person must not engage in the generation of electricity for supply or sale or the transmission, distribution, supply or sale of electricity unless the person is:

- (a) the holder of a licence authorising the relevant activity;
- (b) exempted from the requirement to obtain a licence in respect of the relevant activity; or
- (c) is the holder of a trial waiver in respect of the relevant activity.

Section 18(1) of the Industry Act provides that a person may apply to the commission for a licence authorising the person to generate electricity for supply or sale and to sell electricity (under sub-sections (1)(a) and (d)).

On 20 April 2022, Wangaratta Solar Farm submitted an application to the commission for a licence authorising it to generate electricity for supply or sale, and to sell electricity to the wholesale electricity market.

Consistent with the requirements of the commission's electricity generation licence application form and 'Guideline: Applications for electricity and gas industry licences', Wangaratta Solar Farm provided the commission with necessary documentation supporting the application.

On 15 September 2022, the commission published a copy of the application, and invited interested parties to make submissions in respect of the application. The commission did not receive any submissions regarding the application.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 19(1) of the Industry Act provides that the commission may grant or refuse the application for any reason it considers appropriate, having regard to the objectives of the commission under the provisions of the Industry Act and the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 (Vic) (Commission Act).

DECISION

The commission is satisfied that:

- Wangaratta Solar Farm has the technical capacity to comply with the conditions of the licence to be granted; and
- Wangaratta Solar Farm is a fit and proper person to hold a licence to generate electricity for supply or sale, and to sell electricity in Victoria.

In accordance with Section 19(1) of the Industry Act, and having regard to its objectives under the Commission Act and the Industry Act, the commission has decided to grant Wangaratta Solar Farm a licence to generate electricity for supply or sale, and to sell electricity. This authorisation granted by the licence is limited to the generation of electricity at the Wangaratta Solar Farm in the vicinity of North Wangaratta, Victoria, and the sale of electricity generated by this facility through the wholesale market.
